**SHOW INFORMATION**

The show site will be available to exhibitors on Friday at 12:00 am for setup. The building will be closed at 7:30 p.m. No dogs may be left overnight. There are two rings: 80’x 100’ & 90’x100’. All classes will be held under cover on packed dirt. On-site concessions will be available.

**COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM-UPS**

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class. A warm-up area, consisting of one regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

**MOVE-UPS**

Move-ups for the first day of the trial will be accepted in writing prior to 6:00 p.m. on Monday, March 22, 2010. Send email move-ups to jolleyalice@yahoo.com. Move-ups for the subsequent days of this trial will be accepted no later than 30 minutes after the completion of the trial on Friday or Saturday on forms provided. Move-ups from Novice A to Novice B are NOT allowed.

## DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial-giving club is offering the optional mixed breed classes.

### NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.*

NOTE: If an AKC Field Rep or a Volunteer Measuring Official is present at the trial, all dogs must be measured for a Jump Height Card. Prior to the second birthday, a dog may have one additional measurement after the initial official measuring. The measurement official is to be told the re-measurement is a "challenge" measurement.

### AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place dog in each jump height in each Standard, and Jumpers W/ Weaves classes. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. New Title, MACH ribbons / MACH bars and PAX ribbons will also be awarded. Prizes (\$1.00-\$3.00) will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> place dog in each jump height in Standard and JWW.

When making motel reservations, ask about pet fees and any other restrictions. All motel sites are considered a part of our match. All AKC rules and regulations apply. Exhibitors are expected to maintain their premises and their dogs in a quiet, clean and well-kept manner. Complaints lodged against any exhibitor will be under the auspices of our Match Committee and reported to the AKC. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at all motels.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Pinch collars, prong collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited on trial grounds.

OPAC and West Texas Horse Center assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. OPAC and West Texas Horse Center and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Exhibitors are responsible for picking up after their own dogs. A clearly marked doggy bathroom area will be located outside at the back of the events building.

All dogs present must be on leash or confined to crates when not being judged, except when in the designated warm-up area.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all the obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show. IF THE ENTRY FORM IS PHOTOCOPIED OR FAXED, THE AGREEMENT ON THE BACK OF THE FORM MUST ALSO BE PHOTOCOPIED OR FAXED AND ATTACHED TO THE ENTRY WHEN IT IS MAILED OR FAXED. Unsigned Entry Forms cannot be accepted or entries which specify any conditions as to its acceptance.

No refunds for duplicate entries. However, care will be taken to find duplicates before processing. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors.

Checks that have been returned due to insufficient funds do not constitute a valid entry and will have a \$25.00 service charge attached.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete or be on the trial grounds. For bitches in season, entry fees minus \$10.00 per day will be refunded if a vet's certificate and written notification is provided. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification by 6:00 pm prior to first class of the trial.

OPAC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression, disease, deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No one shall have any recourse or claim against OPAC or any official thereof.

### REFUND POLICY

Entry fees will be refunded if an entry is pulled before the closing date and time. No refunds will be made for any entry pulled after the closing date with the exception of a bitch in heat (see Exhibitor Information).  
 Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly or if a trial cannot open or be completed.

Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no crossover between classes allowed at the same set of trials. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. ## INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner?
